From Timothe, paraglider in Bolivia,

April, the flight season is at its height in La Paz. It's the moment to consider high cellings : +6 thermals, ascents to 5-6000 meters. We still set up the 15 days paraglide tour in the three cordilleras Real, Western and Tunari. Takeoffs between 3 and 4000 meters, with a French paraglider guide who speaks three languages, is experienced and familiar with the country.

We may also set up treks of all kinds of difficulties, like the Inca path, from the most flat in low altitude (1000m), or some with bigger differences in height, to high moutain. The 6000 summits would be reached with a qualified Canadian guide. You may meet communities in some of the villages of the mountain.

We also do classics, like the Titicaca Lake, the Inca ruins, La Paz museums, Uyuni's salars or coloured lagoons and Tarija wines' road. All the best, Thierry, association's treasurer Website:
